Jet ski Experience

Instruction covers:

- Personal Watercraft rules and local regulations
- Layout of a PW, controls, propulsion and steering system
- Personal equipment; wetsuit, personal buoyancy
- Essential safety information; killcord; safe speed; local hazards

Practical – the student CAN:

- Demonstrate the correct use of a killcord at all times
- Board a PW and start the engine
- Control a PW at slow speed,
- Demonstrate a practical understanding of stopping distances

Planing Speed:

- Maintain a good lookout at all times
- Handle corner and control a PW at planning speed

The above 3 modules form <u>part</u> of the RYA Personal Watercraft Safety Course Syllabus but <u>do not</u> constitute a course completion certificate. It is recommended that the student complete them before registering for the R.Y.A. Personal Watercraft Proficiency Course
